Provide a short description of the event and its activities.

From 9 to 11 August 2025, participants from whole Germany engaged in a three-day programme in Leipzig dedicated to exploring how abandoned spaces and assets confiscated from organised crime could be reused for the benefit of local communities. The training began with interactive activities to

get to know each other, build trust, and analyse the key problems related to social reuse. Teambuilding games, group reflections on fears, contributions and expectations, and a study visit to a local initiative helped participants understand the context and challenges.

The second day focused on inspiration and learning from practice. During a *Monitoring Walk*, participants observed the urban environment and reflected on potential opportunities. A *Gallery Walk* showcased good practices and practical tools for change, followed by a *World Café* discussion to identify needs and strategies. Later, the *Social Real Estate Fair* allowed groups to share ideas and form working teams.

On the final day, participants worked on co-creating solutions through *Dragon Dreaming* and *SMART Ideas*, finalised their proposals, and presented them to the group. The event concluded with an evaluation session, commitments for future actions, and the distribution of certificates. Throughout the training, the programme combined learning, inspiration, and hands-on collaboration, equipping participants with the skills, motivation, and network to develop and implement social initiatives in their own communities.
